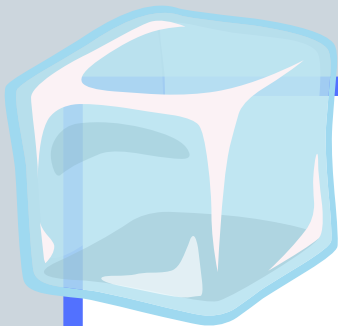

Snow Covered Pretzels

Pretzels
